

Roxbury Probation Officer Receives Prestigious Award

Recently, the New England Council on Crime & Delinquency (NECCD) held their 74th Annual Training Institute in Providence, Rhode Island. At their Awards Luncheon, they presented the prestigious Angelo R. Musto Award to John “Jack” McGrimley, a Roxbury Probation Officer.
